

What sorts of legacy exist?

There are five standard types of legacy:

The Pecuniary Legacy – this simple form of legacy allows you to give a specific sum of money to a named individual or organisation.

The Specific or Non-Money Legacy – you can leave a specific possession to an individual or organisation, such as property, jewellery, antiques, stocks and shares.

The Specific or Non-Money Legacy – pecuniary legacies, debts, fees other liabilities have been met of the specific possession.

The Conditional Legacy – this provides for the eventuality the

The Reversionary Legacy – this is an attractive way of providing for your friends and family first and then benefiting the School. It involves leaving your assets to trustees so

that the beneficiaries can enjoy the income during their lifetime, with the whole or a portion reverting to the school only on their death.

The Residuary Legacy – this involves leaving all or part of your estate to an individual or organisation, after all pecuniary legacies, debts, fees and other liabilities have been met.

Society' formed of similarly philanthropic minded-people who wish to leave a legacy to the School, thereby ensuring its long-term security.

Bursary Support

We can now offer able boys the benefits of an Arnold House education irrespective of their family's financial means. We aim to broaden access to the School through our programme of bursary support, funded for by gifts and legacies. As a new initiative, this is an exciting opportunity to help improve young lives.

Arnold House School is a registered charity and therefore pays no tax whatsoever on gifts of money or property. Certain gifts, including those given to Arnold House, are exempt from inheritance tax and thus can provide tax benefits to your estate. Legacies made to tax-exempt beneficiaries, such as the School or a registered charity, can be deducted from the net value of your estate, thus reducing the amount on which you are liable to pay Inheritance Tax.

Leaving a Legacy

Each and every legacy made to Arnold House counts and we are extremely grateful for a legacy of any size. We aim to make leaving a legacy to the School as rewarding and straightforward for you as possible. You can leave a bequest with complete confidence that it will be acknowledged in a way that has meaning for you and is used with accountability and transparency. We have inaugurated an annual event for members of the George Smart Society and we can provide naming opportunities in some circumstances, or respect your anonymity should you request it.
